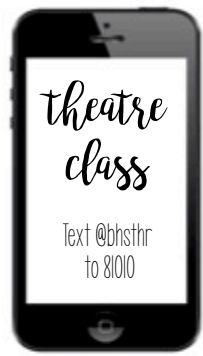

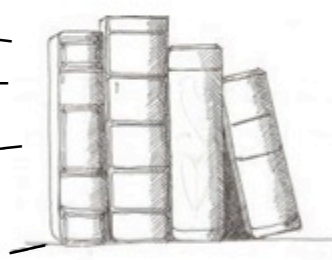

electronic devices
